

## MADISON FAMILY SHELTER

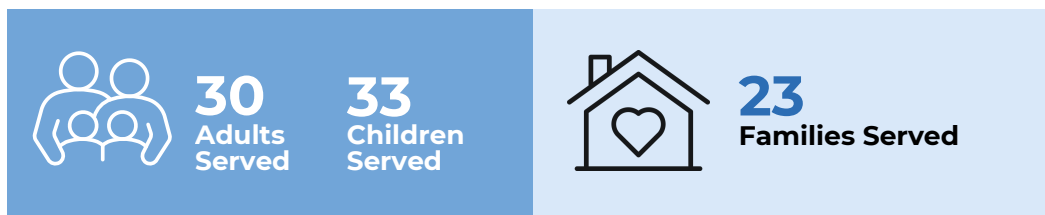
The Interfaith Family Shelter has a mission of helping families with children overcome homelessness and achieve stable housing. We operate approximately 40% of all available family shelter units in Snohomish County, and have one of the highest success rates: about 70% of families exit into permanent housing after the shelter, and about 85% of them are still housed one year later.

Launched in 2024, Madison Family Shelter is an innovative program that extends the cost-effective tiny-home concept to provide eight family shelter units at a single site. Operated in partnership with the City of Everett and Faith Lutheran Church (Everett), this program is an extension of our proven and successful emergency shelter and rehousing program for families with children.

## THE YEAR'S IMPACT



45 families have been served by this program since opening in January 2024.

### 2025 PROGRAM NOTABLES

- **Expanded access to our Children's Program.** Every child in our programs receives the support they need while navigating a difficult time. We brought a formal Children's Program on-site in 2025 that provides daily Learning Hours with access to tutoring and school support, snacks and fun activities, as well as connections to a Child & Family Advocate. We don't let children take a backseat while experiencing homelessness.
- **Brought laundry services on-site.** This site started without laundering services on-site, another barrier families struggle with while homeless. We achieved funding to finally see this happen!
- **Grew partnership with CARE team to move families off the streets quicker:** We realize Interfaith can't do this alone, and that's why we strengthened our referral network with the City of Everett CARE team. This partnership widens our reach to serve families most vulnerable within Everett and the community at large.
